I. Introduction

UAB “INTERNATIONAL PAYMENT UNION”, company code 304917978 (hereinafter – ‘**the Company**’ or ‘**we**’), registered address at J. Basanavičiaus str. 26, Vilnius, the Republic of Lithuania, is an electronic money institution, holding a license No. 39 issued by the Bank of Lithuania on 25 of July 2018.

This Cookies Policy provides you with information about cookies we use and how to control them for our website. By using our website, you are agreeing to the provisions set out in this Cookies Policy.

III. About Cookies

Cookies are text files containing small amounts of information which are downloaded to your device when you visit a website. Cookies are then sent back to the originating website on each subsequent visit, or to another website that recognises those cookies. Cookies are useful because they allow our website to recognise your device.

IV. What Cookies do we use?

Some cookies are allocated to your device only for the duration of your visit to a website, and these are called ‘**session based**’ cookies. These cookies automatically expire at the end of the user session, when the web browser is closed.

Another type of cookie known as ‘**persistent cookies**’ consists of a text file sent by a web server to a web browser, which will be stored by the browser and will remain valid until its set expiry date (unless deleted by the user before the expiry date).

Our website may use five types of cookies: strictly necessary cookies, functionality cookies, analytics cookies, targeting cookies or third party websites’ cookies.

The list of specific cookies that we use on our website, typical parameters, storage period etc. is available below:

- 1) **Strictly Necessary Cookies** – these cookies are essential in order to enable you to move around our website and use its features, such as accessing secure areas of our website. These temporary cookies last only as long as your web browser is open and are used for technical purposes such as enabling better navigation on our website. The website may not function properly without these cookies.
- 2) **Functionality** – these cookies allow our website to remember choices you make (e.g. your user name, language or the region you are in), so that our website can offer you improved and more personalized functions.
- 3) **Analytics** – these cookies analyze how our website is being accessed, used, or is performing in order to provide you with a better user experience and to maintain, operate and continually improve our website. Analytics cookies allow us to better understand our website visitors so that we can improve how we present our content or to improve our website by measuring any errors that occur.
- 4) **Targeting** – these cookies are used to deliver adverts that are relevant to you and your interests.
- 5) **Third Party Websites’ Cookies** – we may use third-party service providers to assist us by providing certain statistical and analytics information. Third Party Websites’ Cookies are set by someone other than us for purposes such as e.g. collecting information on your behavior, demographics, or personalized marketing. These Cookies may be used by partners and advertising networks, such as the Google Display Network to display ads specific to you and in accordance your preferences while using our website. To achieve this goal cookies may store information about your navigation path or the time you spent on your website. In order to see what information was collected about you by the Google Display Network, you can view and edit the information derived from cookies with the following tool provided by Google: <https://www.google.com/ads/preferences/>. We do not have control over the placement of cookies by other websites, even if you are directed to them from our website.

V. How to control and delete Cookies?

There are number ways to manage cookies. You can set your consent or if you wish you can control or delete the placing of cookies on your computer. If you delete the cookies, any settings and preferences controlled by those cookies will be deleted and will need to be re-created when you visit our website subsequently. We have explained how you can exercise this right below:

1) Consent Tool

Our Cookie Consent Tool may be utilized to customize your cookie preferences. The tool will record when you have consented to our cookie policy and will ask for consent again annually to ensure users stay up-to-date with changes to our cookie and privacy policies. The consent tool specifically controls the marketing cookies and analytical cookies set by using our website. Essential cookies cannot be disabled, nor can the tool be used to block cookies on third-party websites linked from our website.

2) Using Your Browser

Most browsers allow you to change your cookies settings. Many of the cookies used on our website and through emails can be enabled or disabled through our consent tool or by disabling the cookies through your browser. However, if you set your browser to block essential cookies, some parts of our website will not then work.
